UPTD ADA PARATRANSIT – VISITOR POLICY

Who is a Visitor?

A visitor is a person with a disability who does not reside in the UPTD service area.

Eligibility for Visitors

Visitors who are ADA Paratransit eligible in another jurisdiction will be recognized as eligible by UPTD.

- No additional application is required
- Documentation of eligibility may be requested

If eligibility documentation is not available:

- Proof of residence may be requested
 - If disability is not apparent, limited documentation may be requested

Length of Service

UPTD will provide ADA Paratransit service to visitors for up to 21 days within a 365-day period.

Visitors staying longer than 21 days may be required to apply for local eligibility.

How to Use UPTD Paratransit as a Visitor

To arrange service:

- Contact UPTD at: 541-440-6500
 - Provide eligibility documentation (if available)
 - Provide local address or place of stay
 - Schedule trips in advance
